



## Excerpts of the Act on Electricity Supply (“Bekendtgørelse af lov om elforsyning”)

*(Notice: This is a translation of the Danish version of the Act on Electricity. The Danish version will always be the one in force and this translation is not legally binding.)*

### **Guarantee of Origin and eco-labeling**

**§ 63 a.** The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building Affairs shall lay down rules on the issue, transfer and cancellation of guarantees of origin for electricity, including about

- 1) what information the guarantee of origin shall contain, and
- 2) conditions to issue, transfer and cancellation of guarantees of origin.

*Paragraph 2.* The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building Affairs shall lay down rules that consumers will receive information about the use of energy sources of the electricity supplied in the last year. The Minister sets rules, that

- 1) the consumer must receive an annual review of the composition of energy sources, and
- 2) the consumer must have access to information on environmental impacts of energy sources by reference to existing, publicly accessible electronic or other sources of specified content.

*Paragraph 3.* The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building may lay down rules on the information referred to in paragraph 2 shall be communicated by the supplier of electricity for each delivery or otherwise in the supply of an electricity exchange or imported from a company outside the European Union and EEA countries.

*Paragraph 4.* The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building Affairs shall lay down rules on documentation of information referred to in paragraph 1 and 2. In addition, the Minister sets rules on supervision and control of origin as referred to in paragraph 1 and the accuracy of the information referred to in paragraph 2.

*Paragraph 5.* The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building may authorize a company or an expert institution or organization to perform specified functions relating to the supervision and control as referred to in paragraph 4.

*Paragraph 6.* When it is shown that prescribed information referred to in paragraph 1 or 2 is false or misleading, The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building can order the author of the information to rectify the situation.

*Paragraph 7.* The Minister of Climate, Energy and Building may lay down rules that that the one requesting guarantees of origin will meet the necessary costs of issuance, transfer and cancellation of guarantees of origin and the control and supervision of the accuracy of the information.
